Health Focused

- By educating communities on ways to nurture healthy uses of technology, we encourage informed conversations between youth and adults
- Promote positive behaviors rather than focusing on what should be avoided.

Victim, Victimizer, Bystander Approach

- TECHNICOOOL approaches its prevention efforts by providing information to all young people and acknowledging that some of the youth that we address may be a victim, victimizer, or bystander of online aggression.
- We also recognize that many children may fall into more than one of these groups.

Emphasis on Adult Responsibility

Prevent Child Abuse Vermont emphasizes adult responsibility in all of its programs.

TECHNICOOOL provides information and resources to adults so that they are better able to safeguard the young people in their lives. Tools for:

- Initiating conversations
- Supervision
- Healthy Role Modeling
- Creation of rules and boundaries are given to the caretaking adults in their lives. Adults are responsible for the protection and safety of children.

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
